- WHEREAS: Burnett County emergency services, such as ambulance, police, and fire departments, have no countywide plan for identifying residents' locations for emergency services, and
WHEREAS: a grid mapping system has been prepared for Burnett County with the assistance of the Northwest Regional Planning Commission for the preparation of maps, and
WHEREAS: these maps have been reviewed by UNION Town Board, Burnett County, and
WHEREAS: the U.S. Postal Department has agreed to utilize the numbering system for area resident addresses upon approval of the town boards, and which numbering system should make the reporting of locations in emergency situations much easier.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the UNION Township Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 17th day of MARCH, 1987, approved the grid system mapping for Burnett County.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT THIS SHALL BE THE OFFICIAL MAP FOR USE BY Emergency Services in UNION Township, Burnett County, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the UNION Township Board of Supervisors hereby:

- 1) Formally adopts the map as the official addresses for their residents.
2) Agrees that implementation of Emergency Numbering System will be completed by January 1, 1990.
3) Install road signs concurrently with Emergency Number.
4) Formally adopts the attached specification sheets for Emergency Numbering System and Road Name Signs.
5) Agrees to annually review the maps for accuracy and update for new resident sites.
