

UNION TOWN ORDINANCE 89-1

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Union, Burnett County, does ordain as follows:

That all holders of a "Class B" Alcoholic Beverage license in the Town of Union, Burnett County, Wisconsin, shall maintain an open and continuing business for a minimum of nine consecutive months in each license year.

SECTION 1 - STATUTORY AUTHORITY: This ordinance is enacted pursuant to Section 125.10 of Wisconsin Statutes.


SECTION 2 - REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION: Violation of this ordinance shall be grounds for license suspension or revocation in accordance with Chapter 125.12 of Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect after its publication and posting as provided by law and with the 1989-90 License Year.


