

ORDINANCE NO. 75-10 OF THE TOWN
OF UNION TO REGULATE BOATING
SPEED AT YELLOW LAKE NARROWS

The Town Board of the Town of Union of Burnett County Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. INTENT. The intent of this ordinance is to regulate boat speed of Yellow Lake Narrows so as to provide for the safety of boaters, swimmers, and any other citizens using the waters of Yellow Lake.

SECTION II. APPLICABILITY AND ENFORCEMENT. Provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Big Yellow Lake and Little Yellow Lake in the area commonly known as the "Narrows". The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the Burnett County Sheriff, his deputies, or the town marshal, if any.

SECTION III. SPEED RESTRICTIONS. It shall be unlawful for any motor-propelled boat to travel the waters known as the "Narrows" between Big Yellow Lake and Little Yellow Lake at any speed greater than the slowest possible speed which will enable the operator to maintain steerage.

SECTION IV. PENALTY. The penalty for violation of Section III, shall be a forfeiture of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 for the first offense and a fine of not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$50.00 for the second and each succeeding offense.
