

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE
AND OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES IN
THE TOWN OF UNION, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Union, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. State Snowmobile Laws Adopted. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, the statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to snowmobiles in the following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted by reference and made part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Acts required to be performed or prohibited by such Statutes are required or prohibited by this ordinance.

- 350.01 (Definitions)
- 350.02 (Crossing Highways)
- 350.03 (Operation of Snowmobiles on or in the Vicinity of a Highway)
- 350.04 (Snowmobile Races, Derbies and Routes)
- 350.05 (Persons under 12 Operating a Snowmobile)
- 350.06 (Firearms and Bows)
- 350.07 (Driving Bear, Deer or other game prohibited)
- 350.08 (Owner Permitting Operation)
- 350.09 (Head Lamps, Tail Lamps and Brakes)
- 350.10 (Miscellaneous Provisions for Snowmobile Operation)
- 350.12 (Registration of Snowmobiles)

Section 2. Snowmobile Routes Designated. (a) Except as provided in ss. 350.02 and 350.03, Wisconsin Statutes, no person shall operate a snowmobile in the Town except as hereinafter designated. The following streets are designated snowmobile routes:

1. Streets.

- (a) Dvorak Road from County Trunk U to Lee Road.
- (b) Lee Road from County Trunk U to Welch Road.
- (c) Welch Road for its entire length.

(d) Shore Road from Yellow Lake Lodge to the town line between Union and Oakland Townships.

(e) Zamzo Road from South River Road to the Clam Flowage.

2. Operation. Snowmobiles operated on designated routes over public highways shall observe the rules of the road for motor vehicles set forth in Chapter 346, Wisconsin Statutes and Sections 3 and 4 of this Code.

Section 3. Additional Regulations. (a) Speed. No person shall operate a snowmobile upon any public right of way or highway within the Town of Union at a speed in excess of that permitted or posted for other motor vehicles.

Section 4. All persons operating a snowmobile upon any public right of way or highway within the Town of Union shall operate said snowmobiles in single file and on the far righthand side of the road.

Section 5. Operation on Private Premises Restricted. No person shall operate a snowmobile on any private property not owned or controlled by him within the Town without the express consent or permission of the owner.

Section 6. Penalty. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$20.00 together with the costs of prosecution for the first offense and not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$50.00 together with costs of prosecution for the second offense within a year.
