

Resolution 2007-12-19

WHEREAS, Wisconsin State Statutes Section 7.30(1) (a) establishes the number of election inspectors to be seven and that wherever voting machines are used, "the municipal government body may reduce the number of inspectors to five," and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin State Statutes Section 7.32 further allows for the reduction of election inspectors at the polling place to not be less than three, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board may deem it necessary to reduce the official number of election inspectors based on the estimated voter attendance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Union, Burnett County hereby sets the minimum number of election inspectors at 3 for each election so that elections are honestly, efficiently and uniformly conducted.

However, the Municipal Clerk may assign additional election inspectors if he or she believes they are needed for a given election.

Marv Merle made a motion to approve the resolution and Wayne Burmeister seconded the motion. The motion to accept the resolution passed unanimously.
