ORDINANCE NO. 76-2

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE PRESENT ORDINANCES  
REGULATING THE USE AND OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES  
IN THE TOWN OF UNION, BURNETT COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Union, Burnett County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1. State Snowmobile Laws Adopted, Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, the statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to snowmobiles in the following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted by reference and made part of this ordinance as is fully set forth herein. Acts required to be performed or prohibited by such Statutes are required or prohibited by this ordinance.

- 350.01 (Definitions)
- 350.02 (Crossing Highways)
- 350.03 (Operation of Snowmobiles on or in the Vicinity of a highway)
- 350.04 (Snowmobile Races, Derbies and Routes)
- 350.05 (Persons under 12 Operating a Snowmobile)
- 350.06 (Firearms and Bows)
- 350.07 (Driving Bear, Deer or other game prohibited)
- 350.08 (Owner Permitting Operation)
- 350.09 (Head Lamps, Tail Lamps and Brakes)
- 350.10 (Miscellaneous Provisions for Snowmobile Operation)
- 350.12 (Registration of Snowmobiles)

Section 2. Snowmobile Routes Designated (A) Except as provided in S.S. 350.02 and 350.03 Wisconsin Statutes, no person shall operate a snowmobile on the streets or roads in the Town except as hereinafter designated. The following streets or roads are designated snowmobile routes:

- A. Dvorak Road between County Trunk U and Lee Road.
- B. Lee Road from County Trunk U to Lincoln Town Line.
- C. Welch Road for its entire length.
- D. South River Road between Cutler Road and Doty Brook.
- E. Cutler Road between South River Road and Clam Flowage.
- F. Cutler Road between South River Road and County Trunk F.
- G. Lisk Road between County Trunk F and North River Road.
- H. North River Road between Lisk Road and North Bailey Road.
- I. South Bailey Road and North Bailey Road.
- J. Pardun Road from County Trunk F.

Section 3. Penalty. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$15.00 or more than \$25.00 together with the costs of prosecution for the first offense and not less than \$25.00 or more than \$50.00 together with costs of prosecution for the second offense within a year.

Section 4. This Ordinance will take effect upon its passage and publication and will supersede present Ordinances.





**Section 3. Penalty.** Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$15.00 or more than \$25.00 together with the costs of prosecution for the first offense and not less than \$25.00 or more than \$50.00 together with costs of prosecution for the second offense within a year.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance will take effect upon its passage and publication and will supersede present Ordinances.
