

Resolution Number 2011-10-19

Resolution of Town Board to Exceed the Levy Limits for 2011

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has imposed levy limits on town, village, city and county tax levies for the year 2011 and thereafter under s. 66.06602 of Wisconsin Statutes;

Whereas, the Board of the Town of Union, Burnett County believes that for the 2011 tax levy (collected in 2012), it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit by a greater percentage than zero to assist in recovering July 1, 2011 storm clean up costs.

Whereas, the Town of Union's allowable levy for 2011 is \$ 118,203; and further whereas the state law would limit the increase to zero for a total allowable town tax levy of \$ 118,203 for 2011 (to be collected in 2012).

Now, therefore, the Town of Union, Burnett County, Wisconsin, does hereby resolve and order as follows:

1. The town board supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2011 (to be collected in 2012) that will exceed the state levy limit to cover 2011 storm clean up.
2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the town tax levy for 2011 (to be collected in 2012) by 25.38% , which would increases the town levy by \$ 30,000 for a total town tax levy of \$ 148,203 shall be placed on the agenda for the special town meeting to be held on November 16, 2011
