WHEREAS the electors of the Town of Union wish to preserve the general peace and tranquility of their town, and

WHEREAS the Town is presently issuing one Class "B" license for the retail sale of beer, and ~~the town board has~~ *1. 10-1-*

~~the town board has~~ WHEREAS the electors of the Town of Union believe that it would be contrary to the best interests of the Town of Union for additional beer licenses to be granted,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF UNION at the annual Town meeting that the Town of Union shall issue no more than one Class "B" license annually for the sale of fermented malt beverages,

UNLESS the following procedure is complied with:

1. Upon receipt of an application for a license for the sale of beer or ~~liquor~~, the town board shall establish a date for a hearing on the application.

2. The Town Clerk shall publish a notice for three consecutive weeks before said hearing. Said notice shall state the date and time of the hearing and the nature of the application to be considered.

3. The hearing shall be before all interested, qualified voters of the Town of Union.

4. A license shall be granted if a majority of the qualified voters present at the meeting vote in favor of the granting of the license.
