

Resolution # 02.2021 Redistricting

To Create Municipal Wards in the County of Burnett County

Town/Village of Union

WHEREAS, following each decennial census each County Board is required to create Supervisor election districts that are substantially equal in population in accordance with Section 5.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Burnett County Board of Supervisors adopted a Tentative County Board Supervisor Redistricting Plan on September 23, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of each municipality required to create words or adjust ward lines to accommodate the tentative county plan is required, as soon as possible, after receipt of the tentative supervisor district plan, to adopt a resolution or ordinance numbering such wards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Union that Ward(s) 1 is created and defined on the attached map; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for all voting purposes, the above ward(s) will be using one common polling place. The polling place, as required by law, is located in Ward One (1); and

BE IT EVEN FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution and map be forwarded to the Burnett County Clerk by October 18, 2021.


# Tentative County Supervisor District Map
