OAKLAND COLLECTION CENTER 2026

The Oakland Collection Center (OCC) is open to all RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OWNERS of Oakland, Swiss and Union Towns for disposal of residential garbage and recycling. Unauthorized use of the OCC card will result in loss of OCC privileges.

The OCC is located at 28558 French Road - approximately five miles south of Danbury. From State Highway 35, turn west on County Road U, then turn north on French Road and drive 9/10th of a mile to the OCC.

You do not need an OCC card to utilize residential recycling services; it is open to all county residents. Businesses should call their waste hauler for recycling information. Recycling and hazardous waste questions may be directed to the Recycling Control Commission at 715-635-2197.

Unlawful dumping outside the OCC gates - \$500.00 fine.

The following recyclables <u>must be empty, clean and dry</u>: corrugated cardboard (flattened), clean boxboard (cereal and pasta boxes), juice boxes and paper milk containers; newspapers, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, phone books, brochures, envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards and file folders; glass beverage and food jars/containers (clear, brown and green); metal food and beverage cans – steel, tin, bimetal and aluminum; and household consumer plastics <u>#1, #2 and #5</u> (absolutely NO automotive product bottles regardless of number).

\$3.00 each for shatter-shield fluorescent tubes over 4 feet

\$7.00 each for tanning bed bulbs

\$3.00 each for HID bulb (High Intensity Discharge)
