**Regular Board Meeting**  
**April 15, 2026**  
**Union Town Hall**

Bob Savage, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:06 p.m.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Waldhauser to approve the agenda for the Regular Board Meeting of April 15, 2026. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/ Dan Waldhauser to approve the minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of March 18, 2026. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/ Dan Waldhauser to approve the March 2026 Treasurer's Report. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/ Dan Waldhauser to approve payment for the April 2026 disbursements. Motion carried 3-0.

The board conducted a brief discussion concerning the 2026 Spring clean-up. Terri McDaniel, the event organizer, informed attendees that she would provide a map for participants to indicate the roads they plan to work on. Garbage may be deposited at the town hall throughout the clean-up period. Safety vests will be available in a bin located at the back entrance of the town hall. Jayne Schwartz noted that if the townships were to formally adopt the roads, the county would handle garbage collection. Given that the clean-up is scheduled to commence in two days, the town will manage waste disposal this year; however, partnering with the county remains a potential option for future events.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Waldhauser to set the dates for the 2026 Spring clean-up for April 17<sup>th</sup> – May 1<sup>st</sup>. Motion carried 3-0.

Keith Mogel attended the meeting to introduce himself as a candidate for State Assembly District 75. He responded to questions and concerns raised by the board regarding issues impacting township residents.

Jayne Schwartz, Town Treasurer, reported that the county is moving to a new software, T-Tech for the upcoming tax collections in the fall. There will be a cost of approximately \$500 - \$600 annually. In addition, there will be some cost for training, to be determined.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Waldhauser to approve moving to T-Tech for the fall of 2026. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion to adjourn by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Waldhauer at 5:26 p.m. Motion carried 3-0.
