Bob Savage, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Walhauser to approve the agenda. Motion carried

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Waldhauser to approve the minutes for the Regular Board Meeting of June 17, 2026. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Waldhauser to approve the June Treasurer's Report. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Waldhauser to approve payment for the June 2026 Disbursements.

Grant Opportunity – Burnett County Tourism Coalition – Grant for \$1,000 being applied for to put towards Pontunes that is held every July out on Little Yellow Lake. Motion by Dan Walhauser/Eugene Sikorski to approve grant submission. Motion carried 3-0.

Quarterly Filing Notice – Kim Johnson to look into notice for late filing.

Mosaic Technologies Request – Fiber optics communications company wants to partner to add additional internet fiber optics in Union Township. Eugene Sikorski will be looking into this company and the agreement and a resolution will be adopted if we decide to move forward with this company.

Discussion on Kim Johnson's resignation and the passing of the duties as of September 1, 2026.

Bass Lake Boat Landing – discussion was held regarding the deterioration of the boat landing. Also discussed was the proposal that was presented back in February of 2026, by Steve Herman. The understanding was that the proposal was going to be updated and presented again to the Union Township Board at a later date.

Bass Lake Boat Landing is owned by Union Township. **Note:** In past years, funds have not been allocated to update boat landings. Local lake associations have typically updated boat landings when needed.

A Motion was made by Dan Waldhauser/Eugene Sikorski to vote on Bass Lake Boating Landing repairs. Motion carried 2-1

A motion was made by Dan Waldhauser/Eugene Sikorski to have a load of gravel allocated to the boat landing up to \$600.00. Motion carried 3-0

Speed Limit signs to be placed on Park as there are no signs posted for speed limits.

Lawn mowing – discussion on next year's contract. There will be a couple items to follow.

1) Put in local paper to get bids. 2) Vote in Fall to keep original lawn person or change every two to three years. This will be a monthly payment to whomever will be the service.

Northwoods Propane – Pre-buy for upcoming year. Last year Union Township purchased \$662.00 worth. Motion was made by Eugene Sikorski/Dan Waldhauser for pre-buy contract for \$700.00. Motion carried 3-0.
